BRUNSWICK FESTIVAL 2024 –17TH & 18TH AUGUST

We Need Volunteers!

Brunswick Festival weekend is 17th and 18th August, however, we also need volunteers (aged 18+) throughout the year and during the weeks leading up to the event.

Volunteer roles throughout the year include:

- Supporting with fundraising – local business sponsorship
- Marketing- designing flyers, posters and supporting social media campaigns
- Supporting with general festival admin
- Managing stall holder communications

Volunteer Roles during the festival:

Thursday 15th - Tuesday 20TH August (Brunswick Square, Hove).

The Festival itself runs over the weekend of 17th and 18th August, but we need help before and after to set up, de-rig and tidy up the Square.

Volunteers would be required to undergo a 1 hr event assistant / steward briefing session prior to the event.

The briefing would cover an awareness of issues and areas such as:

- basic event H&S
- crowd management
- disability access
- public information
- child & vulnerable adult safety policies and procedures
- site security
- vehicle movement on site
- fire safety
- first aid procedures
- welfare arrangements
- emergency procedures

Tasks include:

- Putting up tents, gazebos, décor, signage and other event infrastructure (Thursday to Tuesday)
- Production transport support – collecting / returning equipment/ shopping
- Litter picking & helping recycling
- Running the festival information point

- Shifts on the tea tent
- Bucket collections for donations
- Managing entrances and exits
- General stewarding
- Helping out in the family craft area
- Making breakfast butties for the volunteers
- Documenting events (film, photography, recording)
- Audience and participant surveys, questionnaires, interviews

Festival volunteer shifts are as follows:

- 9am-12noon
- 12noon-3pm
- 3pm-6pm
- 6pm-9pm

All volunteers will receive a lunch and/or dinner vouchers (depending on time / duration of shifts) and free refreshments (water, tea, coffee, soft drinks), travel expenses and a festival T shirt! If you want to camp overnight, you are welcome to stay in one of our bell tents.
