We Need Volunteers!

Brunswick Festival needs volunteers (aged 18+) - throughout the year and in the run up to the event, as well as over the festival weekend.

Volunteer roles throughout the year include:

- Supporting with fundraising – local business sponsorship
- Marketing- designing flyers, posters and supporting social media campaigns
- Supporting with general festival admin

Volunteer Roles during the festival:

The Festival itself runs over the weekend of Saturday 15th and Sunday 16th August 2026. We also need people to help before and after the event on Friday 14th and Monday 17th August to help set up, de-rig and tidy up the Square.

Tasks include:

Friday

- Helping put up bell tents, gazebos and other event infrastructure (fencing etc.)
- Marking out pitches for stall holders
- Managing vehicles on site
- Cordoning off flower beds
- Putting up décor / bunting / signage
- Setting up the stewards tent / info point

Saturday & Sunday

- Making breakfast butties for volunteers (8am)
- General stewarding of entrances and exits and areas around the site (family area/food area/market place/stage etc)
- Directing stall holders to pitches as they arrive
- Helping out on the festival information point
- Helping out in the family craft area / children's parade
- Carrying out bucket collections for donations
- Litter picking & helping with recycling
- Documenting events (film, photography, recording)
- Carrying out audience surveys

Monday

- Helping de-rig and pack down all areas
- Litter picking

Festival volunteer shifts are as follows:

- 9am-12noon
- 12noon-3pm
- 3pm-6pm
- 6pm-9pm

Volunteers are required to undergo a 1 hr briefing session prior to the event. The briefing covers an awareness of various event related issues, responsibilities and procedures such as:

- code of conduct
- basic event H&S awareness
- emergency procedures
- safeguarding awareness
- lost / found child procedures
- disability/access awareness
- first aid and welfare arrangements
- stewarding duties
- site security
- crowd management
- fire safety
- public information
- no dogs rule

We provide refreshments, travel expenses and a festival T-shirt.
